The committee also presented the plans for the next club room expansion to the invited guests which was received positively from both local and state government representatives. The plans include a new commercial kitchen, toilets, expansion of the main room out over the garage which would also include training rooms.

For the club to maintain its growth and membership we need to provide modern up to date facilities. With this in mind the committee will work to secure more grants to ensure the building works upstairs can be completed within a reasonable time frame.
