Patrol and Skills Maintenance Information
Season 2020/21



Overview

Thank you for taking the time to read over this document that outlines important patrol, water safety and skills Maintenance information for the 2020/21 season.

Skills Maintenance

A member's proficiency is valid until the 31st December each year unless stated otherwise (e.g. Provide First Aid has a three-year proficiency requirement). Any member who is not proficient by the 31 December, or has not completed appropriate awards shall not be allowed to:

- Perform patrols
- Operate rescue craft or
- Compete in surf lifesaving competitions, until such time as they have met the proficiency requirements as determined for that season.

Skills maintenance may be conducted after 31st December under the requirements/ approval of the State Lifesaving Executive Committee. Requests for extension to complete Skills Maintenance are to be made in writing to the club at info@cliftonbeachslsc.com.au to then be submitted to the Chair of Lifesaving. Any member completing their proficiency after 31st December each season shall be eligible to patrol but may not be permitted to participate in any SLSA Championship competition until 1 July later in that year (see SLSA Policy 5.04 for further details on competitor proficiency/patrol requirements). When a skills maintenance check is successfully completed (or a member gains a relevant award after 30 June, in a particular year) the proficiency or qualification is current until 31st December in the following season.

This season, due to the COVID-19 pandemic the process for skills maintenance will be conducted in a different way to reduce the need for large gatherings. There will be NO individual skills maintenance sessions conducted, they will ALL be run on your individual patrols. These skills maintenance activities will be conducted in a scaled-back process in-line with SLSA guidelines. It is important to note that online components MUST be completed in order to be deemed proficient for the season.

On your patrol it will be at the discretion of the patrol at what time throughout the day the skills maintenance is completed. However, this must be completed in waves to ensure the water is supervised at all time.

It is important to note that although skills maintenance will be conducted in a different format this season the standard of activities conducted will not change and all normal time limits and standard operating procedures still apply to all relevant activities.

For all IRB Drivers and Crew, you are automatically deemed proficient in these awards, if you have completed logged hours in the IRB from 1 January 2020. However, it is highly recommended that member whilst on patrol practice their driving and crew skills.

What if I am not patrolling but still need to complete skills maintenance? You will need to complete a skills maintenance session in conjunction with a patrol team, please speak with a patrol captain on a weekend you would like to update to find out what time they will complete skills maintenance. We will also be holding a session following nippers for water safety, more information to follow regarding this.

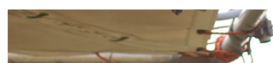



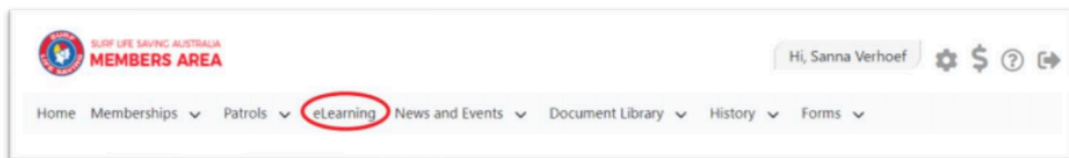
How to access the online Skills Maintenance courses

In order to access the Skills Maintenance online Learning courses and assessment you will need to have a [SLS Members Area](#) account. To log into your account, go to members.sls.com.au and enter your login details. If you do not have a Members Area account, you can easily create one using the create account option. If you don't remember your username or password, you can also easily re-set your password by clicking on the forgot password option.

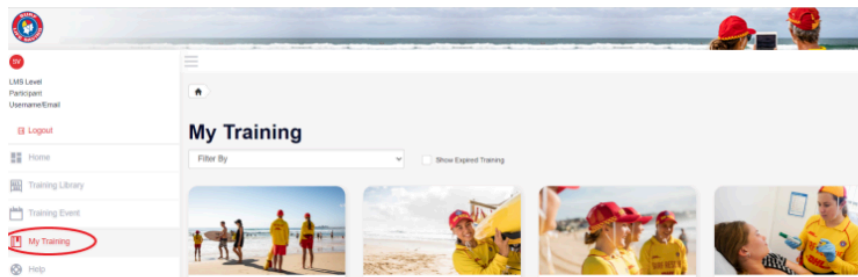
Once you have logged into your SLS Member Area account follow the below steps to access your Skills Maintenance courses.



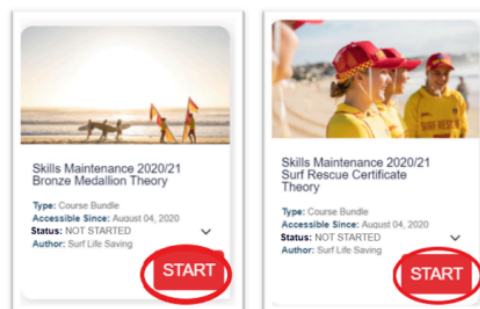
1. Select **eLearning** from the options along the top of the screen.



2. Once you are on the eLearning page, from the options on the left select **My Training**.

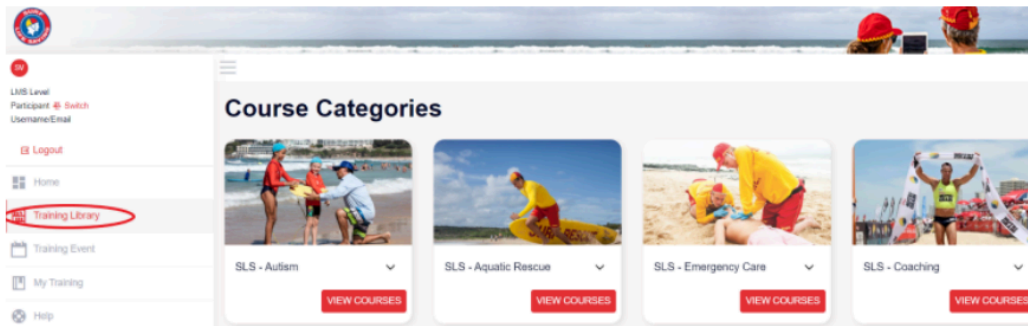


3. Once you have selected the **My Training** option, all the courses in which you are enrolled will appear. Look for the **Skills Maintenance 2020/21 Bronze Medallion Theory** or the **Skills Maintenance 2020/21 Surf Rescue Certificate Theory** course and press on the **Start** button. This will take you to all the modules that you need to complete for your skills maintenance, you must complete each module and the theory questions for the eLearning component to show as complete.

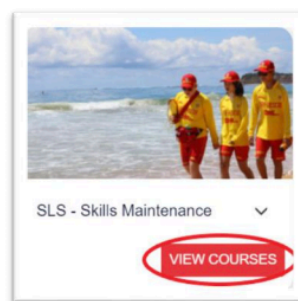


Note: Some members will not have been automatically enrolled into the course. If you can't find the course in your **My Training** then you need to enrol into the course yourself, you can do this by following the remaining steps below.

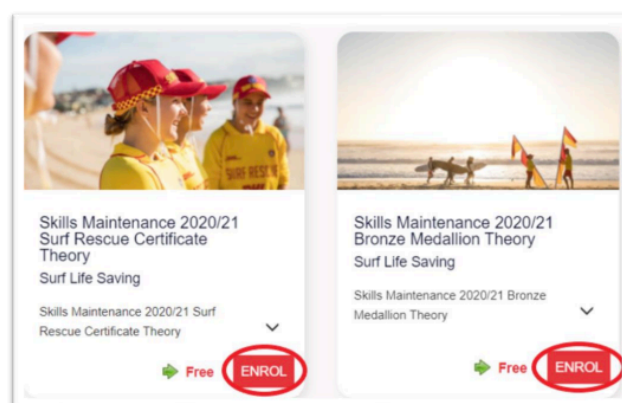
4. From the options on the left select the *Training Library* option. This will take you to all the courses available for enrolment.



5. Look for *SLS – Skills Maintenance* and select *View Courses*



6. Select the course in which you want to enrol, either the *Skills Maintenance 2020/21 Bronze Medallion Theory* or the *Skills Maintenance 2020/21 Surf Rescue Certificate Theory* course and press on the *Enrol* button. This will take you to all the modules that you need to complete for your skills maintenance, you must complete each module and the theory questions for the eLearning component to show as complete.



Note: Now that you are enrolled in the course it will now appear in your *My Training* area, to access the course again, follow steps 1-3 above.
